


# Participation Fees

In order to maintain the current level of sports programming and opportunities for students, the Athletic Department, along with community booster groups and coaches, support the following participation fee schedule for the current school year.

**For families with participants in both athletic and non-athletic activities, please refer to the athletic fee schedule first, then the non-athletic fee schedule.**

- These are district fee schedules and do not preclude individual groups/activities from charging additional fees.
- All fees are non-refundable.
